

Antioch Christian Church Minister of Worship Arts Job Description

Overview

The Minister of Worship Arts will be responsible for a worship team that leads the congregation of Antioch Christian Church in a weekly worship experience that glorifies God, affirms the preached word, encourages participation—and promotes love, unity, and a spirit-filled environment.

The Minister of Worship Arts will work in partnership with ACC's worship technology team, church secretary, and ministerial staff to ensure that sound system operation, video presentation software (Pro-Presenter), sanctuary lighting, video live-streaming, video editing, planning center, and social media platforms are working properly and being utilized fully.

The Minister of Worship Arts will work with the ACC staff as part of a team for casting vision, making disciples, planning events and sermons, and responding to ministry needs.

Duties

- Serve as our worship team leader and facilitator; responsible for overseeing song selections for both traditional and contemporary worship services each Sunday.
- Organize, schedule, practice with, and participate on worship teams; including online notifications of weekly music and song selections, schedules, and responsibilities to all participants via Planning Center.
- Be responsible for copyright compliance on the ACC media pages and during the worship service.
- Schedule worship service musicians and vocalists.
- Help plan and coordinate special music and/or outreach events (e.g., Worship in the Park).
- Help plan and coordinate special worship services, (e.g., monthly Wednesday Connect Worship, Easter, and Christmas Eve).
- Be present for weekly Sunday morning practices, worship services, and staff meetings; and monthly elders' and board meetings.
- Be responsible for scheduling (and training when necessary) members of the worship technology team; including sound, video, and on-line broadcast technicians for all Sunday morning services.

- Must ensure that the weekly worship service is edited and uploaded to social media.

Qualifications

- Strong organizational and leadership skills, with the ability to meet deadlines promptly.
- Takes initiative and is self-motivated.
- Able to work as a team with volunteer vocalists and instrumental musicians (including current volunteers and musicians); and to build volunteer teams.
- Knowledgeable of both contemporary and traditional worship music.
- Ability to lead vocally is beneficial.
- Keyboard or guitar experience is desirable.
- Proficiency in modern worship and social media technology and social media platforms; including sound system operation and trouble-shooting, video presentation software (Pro-Presenter), video live-streaming, video editing, and Planning Center.

Expectations

- Fully embrace the mission and vision of Antioch Christian Church.
- Personal doctrine must be consistent with Antioch Christian Church's stated beliefs and values.
- Live a consistent Christian life (i.e., demonstrate Christian integrity both personally and professionally).
- Use appropriate judgment in areas of discretion, sensitivity, and confidentiality.
- Have a cooperative, healthy, and motivating relationship with co-workers and volunteers.
